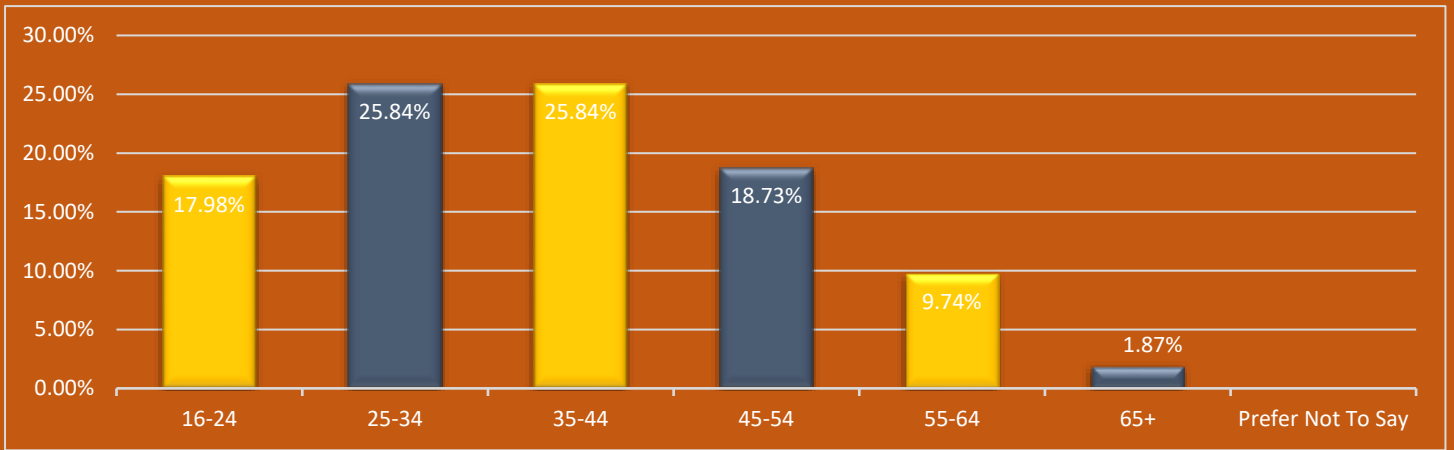
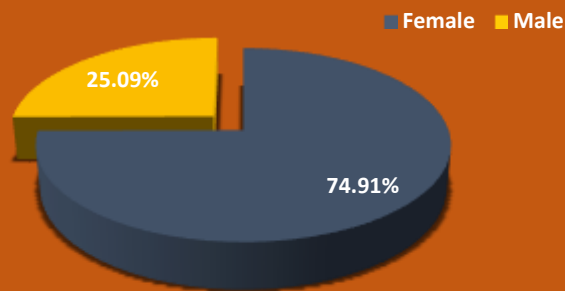

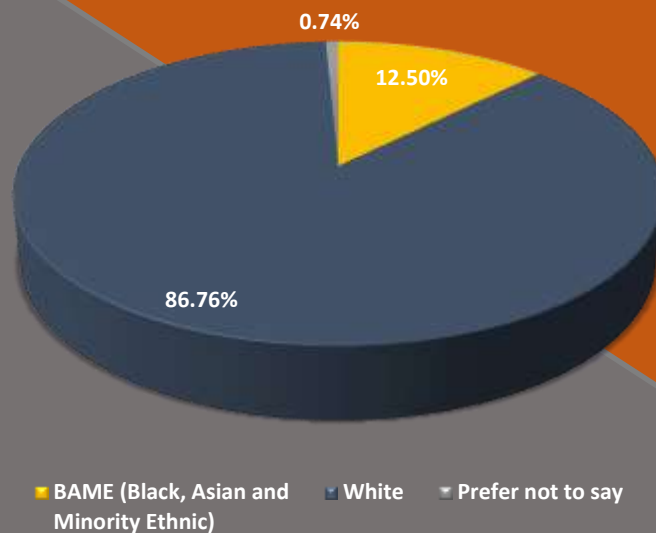

## GENDER



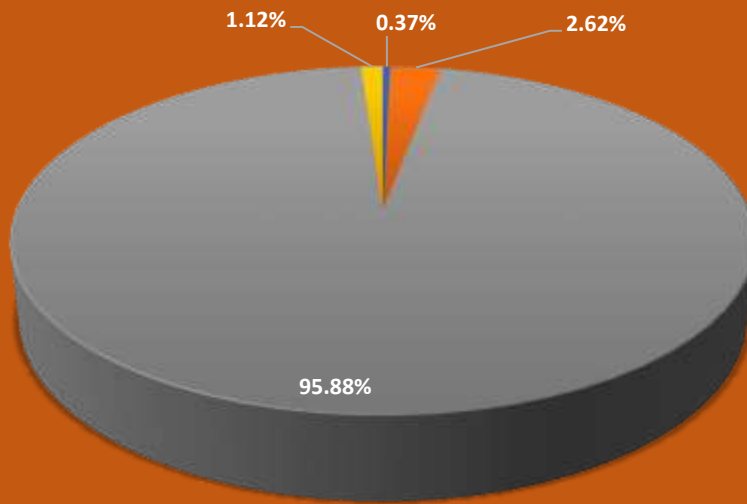

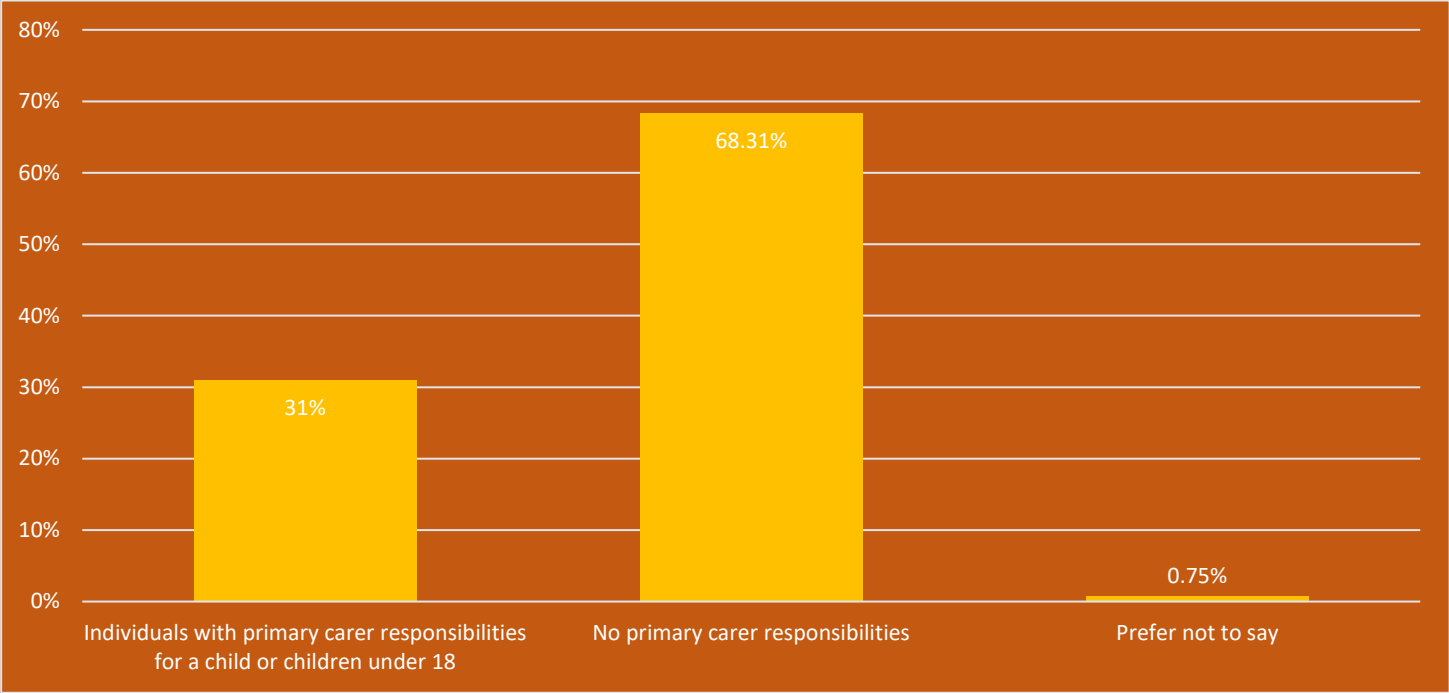

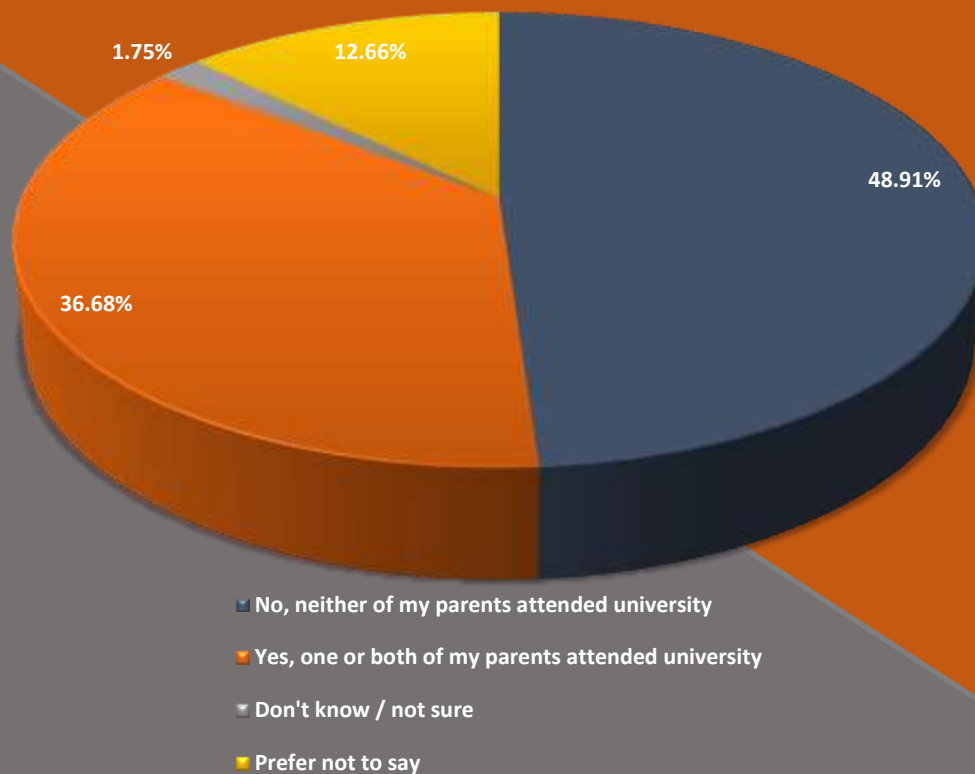

2. Senior, middle or junior managers or administrators such as: finance manager, chief executive, large business owner, office manager, retail manager, bank manager, restaurant manager, warehouse manager	15.64%
3. Clerical and intermediate occupations such as: secretary, personal assistant, call centre agent, clerical worker, nursery nurse	7.11%
4. Technical and craft occupations such as: motor mechanic, plumber, printer, electrician, gardener, train driver	19.43%
